



CRITERIA FOR 2008 CFMA CHARLOTTE CHAPTER AWARDS

2008 EXECUTIVE OF THE YEAR

The purpose of the award is to recognize an area Construction Executive (executive level of management) who understands the importance of involving the financial function within the company in the decision making process. Furthermore, the individual has illustrated an innovative approach to capitalizing on the financial resources of his or her organization to further the success of the company. Finally, the individual has consistently demonstrated a commitment to the community. The nominated individual does not have to be a member of CFMA, but must be employed in construction or a related industry (i.e., real estate development).

2008 ASSOCIATE MEMBER OF THE YEAR

The Charlotte Area Chapter of CFMA is announcing its annual Associate Member of the Year Award. The purpose of the award is to recognize an associate member company of CFMA who regularly contributes to CFMA activities on both a local and national basis. This company should provide a significant service to the construction industry. Finally, this company promotes CFMA to peers and regularly recruits new members. At least one employee of the nominated company must be a member of CFMA.

2008 SUBCONTRACTOR OF THE YEAR

The Charlotte Area Chapter of CFMA is announcing its annual Subcontractor of the Year Award. The purpose of the award is to recognize an area subcontractor that through example has enhanced the image of the construction industry and subcontractors. These achievements may be through promotion of work place ethics, safety awareness, enhanced use of technology and internal financial resources, and overall maintains a proactive and professional relationship with primary contractors. An ideal company will also play a proactive leadership role in the promotion of construction industry legislation and regulations. Finally, the company has consistently demonstrated a commitment to the community.

2008 ROBERT BRANAN AWARD

The Charlotte Chapter uses the same criteria used for CFMA National's Joe Quigley Memorial Award. Nominees may be either a General or an Associate Member. The criteria for consideration include, but are not limited to the following:

- Enthusiasm in the promotion of CFMA at the chapter level
- Contribution at the local chapter level (including participation in CFMA functions and committees)
- Activities that support CFMA's Mission Statement
- Consideration for and service to fellow CFMA members and the local community
